Specific responsibilities of the position include:

- Provide all employees and residents at the Healing Lodges with access to relevant spiritual and cultural teachings.
- Work cooperatively with all staff including the Parole officers, Primary Workers and the Director as well as collaborate with community agencies in order to best support the needs of the residents.
- Act as an additional liaison and support to the relationship between other NCSA programs, residents and staff as required.

Our ideal candidate would have the following qualifications:

- In-depth experience and working knowledge of Indigenous communities, cultures, healing, and language.
- Demonstrated understanding of historic trauma and the impact of colonization on Indigenous people.
- Acknowledged by the Indigenous community as someone with cultural knowledge and teachings.
- Previous history working with individuals in a group setting and one-on-one with an emphasis on meeting the needs of vulnerable populations.
- Consultation skills to work with other Elders, Indigenous communities, Native Counselling Services of Alberta staff, Healing Lodges' residents.
- Good working knowledge of computers and information technology.
- Strong interpersonal relations, conflict resolution, leadership and time management skills.
- Must have a reliable vehicle, valid Alberta driver's license with required liability insurance and confirmation of insurance coverage to transport clients.
- Must provide a completed a criminal record check, child intervention check and may be required to pass a provincial or federal government security clearance.
